Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Pre-Order Catalogs

Catalogs may be pre-ordered at \$3.00 per catalog. Please include payment with your entry fees. A limited number of catalogs will be available for purchase at the trial for \$4.00 per catalog.

Notice to Exhibitors

- THE TRIAL SITE will be available at 7:00 am. Judging will start at 8:00 am.
- The building will be available for set up on Friday, Oct 25 from 4:00 pm 6:30 pm.
- CRATING in designated areas only. CRATE SPACE IS LIMITED. X-pens will not be allowed in the building. Dogs must be removed from the Trial site immediately following the conclusion of the judging on Sunday, Oct 27. There will be no space for un-entered dogs.
- No RV or Overnight parking allowed at the Trial Site.
- Belle-City Kennel Club, Inc. and its members assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

- ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners and handlers are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such error or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please print plainly or type all information on your entry to help avoid errors.
- A RECORDING FEE of 50 cents and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee are required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. A \$3.50 Event Service fee is required for each additional entry of the same dog. These fee are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2).
- A RECORDING FEE of \$3.50 is required for each entry at any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 4).
- Canadian Exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with international money orders in U.S. funds.
- NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.
- ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.
- NO ENTRY FEES will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fi re, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of Belle-City Kennel Club.
- Since <u>bitches in season</u> are not allowed to compete in AKC Obedience or Rally Trials, the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per trial for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive <u>written notification</u> from a veterinarian of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or postmarked <u>before the trial commences</u>.
- Checks for canceled entries will be shredded; no checks will be returned.
