Veterans Class – For dogs and bitches seven (7) years of age or older as of the date of the show.

*Neutered dogs & spayed bitches will be allowed to compete in Veterans Classes
 (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 8)*

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Rabies Vaccination Certificate - Missouri requires you to have proof of current rabies vaccination with you. Tags are not accepted.

Sweepstakes - 1st Show Each Day

Puppy Sweepstakes Requirements

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Vizslas who will be six (6) months and under eighteen (18) months of age on the day of the show. Puppies in Sweepstakes must also be entered in a regular class at the regular fee and on the same entry form under the same event number. Indicate your Sweepstakes class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class". Professional handlers may only show dogs owned or co-owned by themselves or their immediate family.

Puppy Sweepstakes Classifications

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

- Puppy, 6 Months & Under 9 Months
- Puppy, 9 Months & Under 12 Months
- 12 Months & Under 18 Months

Veterans Sweepstakes Requirements

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Vizslas seven (7) years or older on the day of the show. Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular classes or at the regular entry fee. Indicate your Veteran Sweepstakes class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class". Professional handlers may only show dogs owned or co-owned by themselves or their immediate family.

Veteran Sweepstakes Classifications

The following class will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

- Veteran, 7 Years & Under 9 Years
- Veteran, 9 Years & Under 11 Years
- Veteran, 11 Years & Over

Division of Entry Money as Prizes for Puppy Sweepstakes and Veteran Sweepstakes

Thirty-five percent (35%) of the total entry fees will be retained by the Club for expenses. The remaining sixty-five percent (65%) of entry fees for the class will be divided as follows:

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION (Junior Showmanship Classes will not be divided)

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - will be for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy Competition 2nd Show Each Day

Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. The class is NOT divided by sex.

Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may not personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed may compete in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.
- Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

Judging

- Exhibitors should open their dog's mouth for examination.
- Male puppies without 2 fully descended testicles need not be disqualified or excused but the judge's book must describe the condition and Certificate of Merit points must be withheld.
- Dogs with breed standard disqualifications should not be excused but may not receive placements. However, dogs with age related disqualifications such as color (as related to age), height, teeth etc. are permitted to receive awards in the 4-to-6 Month Puppy classes.
- Dogs must be excused for attacking a person or other dogs.
- No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Entries close at 6:00 pm, October 7, 2020. Fees must accompany entries. The Club and/or its Show Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by owner or agent of the owner. The Club and its Show Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or the owner's agent entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete nor for entering the same dog twice.

The show site will be available to exhibitors at 7:00 am.

ENTRY REFUNDS: Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the show committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no entry fee refund for duplicate entry or for bitches in season.

COVID-19 REFUNDS: Should these Specialties, in their entirety, be cancelled due to the Covid-19 Pandemic, Entry Fees will be refunded to the Exhibitor of record in total.

DECLINE OF ENTRY: Gateway Vizsla Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes; and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

NO-REFUNDS POLICY: No entry fees will be refunded if it is impossible to open or complete the show because of riots, civil disturbances, fires, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, acts of a public enemy or other acts or causes beyond the control of the club or the Show Secretary.

CRATING: Exhibitors are welcome to crate dogs within personal vehicles or set-up personal tents/awnings on the grounds, no closer than a 12-Foot perimeter from the ring. Personal tents/awnings must have a 6-Foot perimeter in all directions from the next exhibitor. Dogs may NOT be left in the crating area after posted show hours. Hours of access will be 7:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M Saturday, October 24 & Sunday, October 25. All crates must have an ID with cell phone number clearly marked. Owners/Handlers will be responsible for their dogs and will be asked to relocate them if they cause a nuisance by barking or disturbing other exhibitors. There will be no security in the crating area.

DOG EXERCISE AREA: Dogs may be exercised at the perimeter of the show field. Owners/Handlers **MUST** clean-up after their dogs. No exceptions. Please be respectful at your hotel/motel and pick-up after your dogs at those locations as well!

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees and signatures.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. We can not accept credit card payments for entry fees.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by email prior to close of entries. **Those received by telephone are not acceptable.**

Force Majeure. In the event that Gateway Vizsla Club is unable to perform these Specialties due to acts of God, strikes, equipment, Pandemic, or other factors reasonably beyond its control, Gateway Vizsla Club shall not be liable for damages to Participants resulting from such failure to perform or otherwise from such causes. If these Specialties are cancelled due to Pandemic, Registration Fees will be returned.

Safety Precautions. Gateway Vizsla Club assumes no responsibility with respect to accidents, illnesses, or claims arising out of any activity performed during these Dog Show Specialties. Participant shall take necessary steps to ensure or protect himself/herself and its animals. Participant agrees to comply with all applicable local, state, and federal occupational and safety acts, rules, and regulations. Gateway Vizsla Club will provide Policies & Procedures for participation in these Dog Show Specialties.

SPECIAL NOTICE RELATED TO COVID-19

Gateway Vizsla Club, Officials, Judges, and Exhibitors are required to follow guidelines and regulations established by City of Pacific, Franklin County, State of Missouri and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

Face Coverings/Masks are required for all Judges, Volunteers, and Exhibitors whenever in attendance on show grounds. Face Coverings/Masks must properly cover both nose and mouth. Face Shields are considered an acceptable face covering.

Social Distancing of 6-Feet must be practiced whenever in attendance on show grounds. All Judges, Volunteers, and Exhibitors must avoid shaking hands, hugging or other physical contact, including avoiding contact with dogs who are not Exhibitor's responsibility.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons.

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
