

GATEWAY VIZSLA CLUB & VIZSLA CLUB OF AMERICA – Fall Specialty Policies, Procedures & Waiver for October 24 & 25, 2020

Gateway Vizsla Club & Vizsla Club of America wish to offer an event which provides the highest level of safety and health to all participants, while being fun and celebrating our beautiful breed, Vizslas. In respect of our goals for this event, we are providing the following Policies and Procedures.

Gateway Vizsla Club & Vizsla Club of America will strive to remain consistent in these Policies and Procedures with the City of Pacific, the County in which it resides, the State of Missouri, and the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention (CDC).

General

1. Judging will follow AKC Guidelines for safety and health.
2. Everyone MUST wear a face mask at all times when in the Show Ring as well as a 16' Perimeter around the ring.
3. Participants are responsible for their own face masks.
4. Social distancing of 6-feet is required.
5. Porta-Potties or Restrooms are available for your use. Only one person should occupy a Restroom Stall at a time.
6. Participants must use Social Distancing when signing-in for all classes:
 - a. If possible, know your Participant Number in Advance. Limited catalogs will be available to show Vizsla name & number.
 - b. Sign-In by picking up your Participant Number at a table near the Gate Steward.
 - c. Numbers & Rubberbands will be spread out on the Sign-In table.
7. Gate Stewards will be set-up near entrance to the Show Ring. Gate Stewards will be responsible for flow to and from the Show Ring.
8. Placement Ribbons will be picked-up at exit to the Show Ring. Prior to the show, ribbons will be handled with gloves.
9. Gloves will be available for Judges. Participants are responsible for their own gloves.
10. Judges will deliver judging sheets to the Show Secretary.
11. A 6-foot bubble will be maintained around the Show Secretary.
12. Crating & Seating will be spread out and will maintain Social Distance between Participants:
 - a. Crates may be placed outside of the 12' Perimeter.
 - b. Chairs must be placed 6 feet apart from other Participants.
13. Lunch will NOT be served. Local restaurants are close; however, you may wish to bring a sack lunch.
14. The number of Participants within the Show Ring and 16' Perimeter will be defined in accordance with Local, State & Federal laws/orders in effect at the date and time of these shows.
15. Gateway Vizsla Club & Vizsla Club of America will announce approximate start times for each Show after closing. Participants are asked to limit their time in the immediate area of the Show Ring.
16. Participants should use trash & poop disposal bins appropriately.

As the Participant (or Guardian of a minor) I have read all of these precautions and will adhere to them. If I do not adhere to the above Policies and Procedures, I will forfeit my entry fees and will be asked to leave and not return. My signature below confirms that I voluntarily attest, to the best of my knowledge, that at the time of signing this Waiver, I: (1) do not have COVID-19; and (2) have not been in contact with or exposed to any known carrier of COVID-19 within the past 14 days. I further attest that I am not currently displaying or feeling symptoms of COVID-19 (including, but not limited to, coughing, sneezing, elevated temperature, or any other symptom(s) that the United States Center for Disease Control has attributed to COVID-19).
